Good morning! A brief email today, with one or two things for Sunday's service. We'll be in our usual place, <https://tinyurl.com/wgkrpcq> for 10.30am.

- It is *Trinity Sunday* tomorrow, which marks the end of the special church season which began back on Ash Wednesday, 26th February. Since then we've had Lent, Easter and Pentecost, and the CofE now moves into what's called 'Ordinary Time'. Apart from one or two special Sundays, the next season we get to is Advent. For the next 6 months, the focus is on how we live as disciples in day to day life. That starts tomorrow, as we look at Jesus 'Great Commission' to the church - to make disciples of all nations.

- Childrens activities: attached are 3 activities you could do with children in your household, or pass on to other children you know, which link to our worship tomorrow. In the 'making disciple for Jesus' sheet you could help your child fill in some specific examples of how they could pray, offer friendship etc. If you have any beads or dominoes in the house, do have those ready on Sunday morning too!
